**Summer Tips to be followed: -**

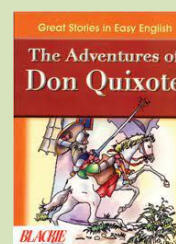

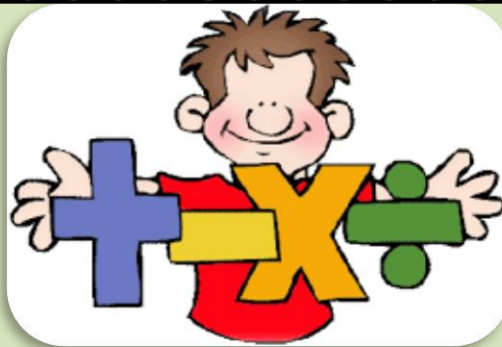

Reading is an exercise for the mind. Kids who read grow up to have better cognitive skills.

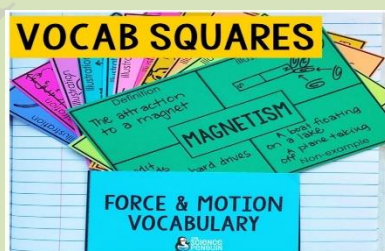
Dear students, it is the best time to explore your reading skills. Given below are some examples of science books. These books are suggested for reading or you can also read any other science book available online.

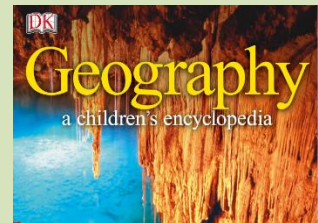
