- Digital public infrastructure - Roll No 21 onwards

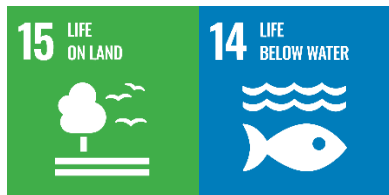
3) Art Integrated Activity-
